Take exit 250 toward Tenth Street/Fourteenth Street/GA Tech. Stay straight to go onto Williams Street NW. Turn right onto 10th Street NW. Turn left on Peachtree Street NE. Stay in the far left lane. The building will be on the left. The underground Parking Deck is **AFTER** the Oceanaire Seafood Room Restaurant which is attached to the office building.

I-85S/I-75S

Before or after the Merge of I75/85 Look for 17th Street exit
Take the 17th St exit, toward 14th St/10th St
Take the ramp toward 14th St/10th St W.
Turn left onto 14th St NW/US-19 N/GA-9 N.
Continue to follow 14th St NW.
Turn right onto Peachtree St NE
1100 Peachtree St NE is on the right.
The underground Parking Deck is **BEFORE** the Oceanaire Seafood Room Restaurant which is attached to the office building.

I-20E

Take Exit 57 to merge onto I-17N/I-85N toward Chattanooga/Greenville
Take Exit 250 toward Tenth St/Fourteenth St/Georgia Tech (follow directions above)
