Directions to the ToolBank

Mass Transit (MARTA)

You may take either the Atlanta Ave #97 bus or the Orchard Knob (#55) bus from Five Points Station.

From I-75/85 Heading South

Take the Fulton Street Exit (first exit after the I-20 exit) Take a left onto Fulton St at the end of the ramp

Turn right on Capitol Avenue (at the Olympic torch) - this street becomes Hank Aaron Drive

You will pass Turner Field on the right

At the second traffic light after Turner Field, turn left onto Atlanta Avenue

Take the first left onto Fraser Street

The ToolBank is the only building on the right, at the corner of Fraser and Ormond

From I-75/85 Heading North

Take the Capitol/Abernathy/Stadium exit (last exit before I20 exit)

At the stop sign at the end of the exit, proceed straight on Ormond Street

Turn right on Hank Aaron when you can't go any further

Take the first left onto Atlanta Avenue

Take the first left onto Fraser Street

The ToolBank is the only building on the right, at the corner of Fraser and Ormond

From I-20 Heading West Towards

Birmingham Take the Capitol Avenue Exit (just before I-20 exit)

Turn left on Capitol Avenue at the end of the off-ramp.

This turns into Hank Aaron Dr

You will pass Turner Field on the right

At the second traffic light after Turner Field, turn left onto Atlanta Avenue

Take the first left onto Fraser Street

The ToolBank is the only building on the right, at the corner of Fraser and Ormond

From I-20 Heading East Towards Augusta

Take the Windsor/Spring/Stadium exit (just before I-20 exit) Turn right onto Windsor St

Take a left onto Fulton St

Turn right on Capitol Avenue after passing over I-75/85. This turns into Hank Aaron Dr

You will pass Turner Field on the right

At the second traffic light after Turner Field, turn left onto Atlanta Avenue

Take the first left onto Fraser Street

The ToolBank is the only building on the right, at the corner of Fraser and Ormond

From Downtown

Get on Capitol Avenue heading South towards Turner Field. This turns into Hank Aaron

You will pass Turner Field on the right

At the second traffic light after Turner Field, turn left onto Atlanta Avenue

Take the first left onto Fraser Street

The ToolBank is the only building on the right, at the corner of Fraser and Ormond
